Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Heavy rain across parts of southeast England will soon clear.
Thereafter, a day of sunshine and showers with the heaviest and most frequent showers in the west, some of them with hail and thunder and falling as snow over hills. It will feel chilly in strong winds with gales developing for a time across southern areas with very strong gusts near heavy showers.
Tonight, showers dying down, but further very wet and very windy weather will spread to many southern and southwestern areas by morning..

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Remaining very unsettled with showers or longer spells of rain. Heavy rain and severe gales are likely across England and Wales on Monday, perhaps with damaging storms in the south.
