

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Sunday 13 May 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cloudy start is expected across central England with outbreaks of rain, and these will move over eastern parts during Monday morning. That rain should then clear in the afternoon. Otherwise a mixture of sunny spells and scattered showers is expected, although thicker cloud and some light rain may reach N.Ireland later on. Temperatures around normal.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Dry in the east initially on Tuesday, but cloud and rain in the west will spread across most parts through the day. Fine generally over Scotland though. Sunny spells and showers widely on Wednesday, with rain reaching the northwest later. Temperatures around normal.
