Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be a frosty start in many areas. For central and eastern areas, cloud will increase with scattered light sleet showers developing, perhaps of snow in east Kent at times. Most other areas will remain dry with bright or sunny spells, but cloud and rain reaching northwest Scotland later. Winds generally light, but feeling chilly.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
A few rain or sleet showers are possible in places on Sunday, but most places dry especially in the west. Cloud will increase in the northwest with further rain at times. Frosty overnight, then rain sleet and snow will spread southwards on Monday.
