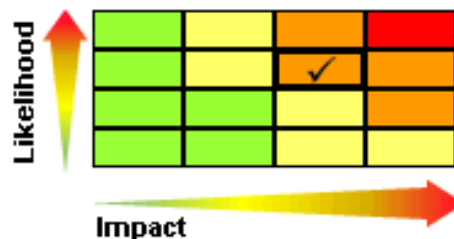
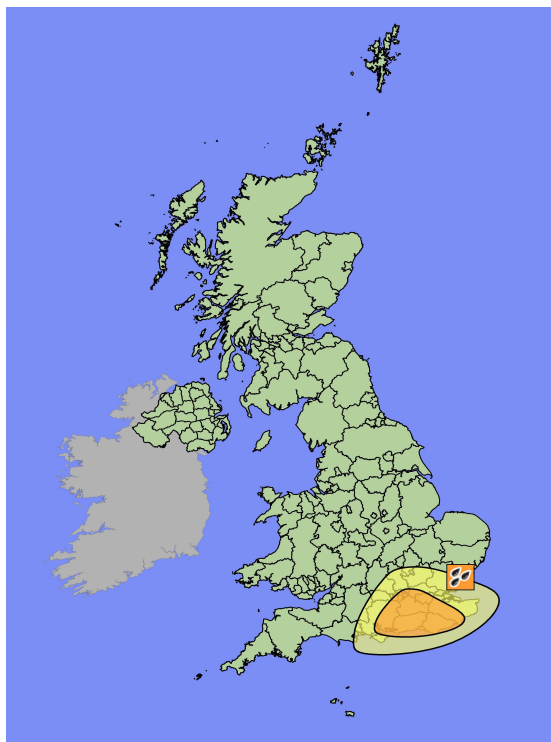




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A shallow depression will remain slow-moving near, or over, southeast England for much of Monday. This will continue to bring heavy rainfall in many places, with totals of 20 to 40 mm quite widely and possibly exceeding 80 mm at a few locations within the amber warning area. The more persistent rain may ease from the southeast during the day, although any brighter spells could allow scattered thunderstorms to develop in similar areas, most likely south of London, and potentially leading to rapid onset of surface water flooding.

There remains some uncertainty about the exact areas which will catch the heaviest rain, and further updates may yet be issued.

The Met Office have issued an **Amber Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:05 on Mon, 11th Jun 2012** until **23:55 on Mon, 11th Jun 2012**

Rain, heavy at times will persist well into Monday, before gradually easing away westwards during the afternoon. Further thundery downpours are possible in the southeast later.

The public should be prepared for surface water flooding and localised river flooding, as well as very difficult driving conditions.

This warning has been upgraded to amber on the basis of latest computer model output and observations, with some adjustments also to the area covered by the yellow warning.
