Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Another bitterly cold day with ice and snow across much of the UK, the snow will be most persistent in eastern and southern areas. However, Northern Ireland and western Scotland will be mostly dry with sunny spells. Overnight, snow showers will retreat to eastern coasts leaving a dry and clear night for many, but with very low temperatures.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Remaining very cold with a band of sleet and snow affecting Northern Ireland and the northwest of Scotland, slowly moving across the UK during Friday. Saturday will be rather cloudy, with further wintry showers for most places across the UK.
