Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
England, Wales and Northern Ireland will be rather cloudy today with light rain in places. It will become cold overnight as skies clear in all but southern England. Scotland will see sunny spells today and with largely clear skies overnight it will become frosty. Scattered showers will affect the north and northeast, these becoming increasingly wintry.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Outbreaks of rain will affect some southern counties on Saturday but should clear on Sunday. Other parts of the UK will see sunshine and scattered showers. The showers will be wintry over Scotland. It will feel chilly, with frosts forming overnight in places.
