Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Strong winds, cloud and occasional spells of rain will continue to affect northwest Scotland today. The rest of the UK will experience another day of sunshine and showers. Showers may align in bands and be thundery at times. Feeling warm in sunny spells. Thundery showers will continue into the evening, then becoming mainly dry away from far western coasts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Showers and fresh winds over Scotland and Northern Ireland. Rain spreading from the southwest to northeast England throughout the day on Sunday. Further southeast, remaining mainly dry with sunny spells. Heavy rain for England and Wales Monday, slowly clearing northeast overnight.
