Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cold and frosty start for many, with patchy ice in the far west and east.
Cloud amounts will generally increase throughout the day, with rain, sleet and hill snow spreading into western parts by the afternoon. Eastern areas are most likely to remain dry and bright throughout the day with perhaps a few coastal showers. Feeling cold for all.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Many areas remaining largely cloudy through much of Friday. Patchy light rain, sleet and snow will slowly ease through the day with many places becoming dry. Frost developing quite widely overnight. Most places remaining dry but rather cloudy through Saturday.
