

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 23 Jun 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showery rain continuing over northern Scotland. Isolated showers are possible elsewhere, most likely in eastern areas, where a few places could catch a heavy and possibly thundery downpour. But dry, sunny and warm for much of central and southern UK. Sporadic showery rain continuing over northeastern parts overnight. Elsewhere, generally dry conditions with clear spells.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cloudy with patchy rain affecting north-eastern areas Tuesday, feeling cooler. Elsewhere, mainly dry with good sunny spells and feeling warm. Showers, heavy at times, possible in the southeast later. Turning more unsettled later on Wednesday in the west, with showery outbreaks of rain likely later.
