Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Low cloud and fog patches at first in the south, with coastal fog patches lingering in places. Otherwise, a largely dry day with sunny spells. A little more cloud for western Scotland and Northern Ireland, with a few showers possible. Tonight, mist or fog patches in the south, often cloudy in the north, but otherwise dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Largely dry and fine again on Friday, with bright or sunny spells for most. Feeling warm with light winds. Remaining fairly cloudy though in the north. Another dry, warm and sunny day on Saturday, but the breeze will pick up.
