Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry start for many areas, but showers will break out across the much of the UK during the morning with a band of more persistent rain spreading into the Southwest through the afternoon. This will spread northeastwards during the evening and overnight to affect south Wales, central and southern England.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Wet in the southeast on Tuesday with rain, heavy at times, gradually clearing during the day. Elsewhere will see sunny spells and scattered showers, some of which will be locally heavy with a risk of thunder. Remaining unsettled on Wednesday with further rain or showers for all parts.
