

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Frequent blustery snow showers will affect northern and western parts of the UK with building accumulations. Elsewhere it will be mainly dry and sunny with isolated wintry showers; but feeling bitterly cold with strong winds. Similar wintry conditions will persist overnight for north and western areas with winds gradually easing.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The cold weather will continue on Saturday but snow showers will gradually ease from the west, with sunshine for many. Feeling very cold, especially along North Sea coasts in brisk winds. Rain will arrive from the southwest on Sunday, turning to snow for many central areas with significant accumulations possible.
