Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of the UK will have a dry day with sunny periods although the far south may be more cloudy at times with a few showers, and with scattered showers continuing to affect the west and far north of Scotland. Although still breezy in exposed northern parts it will be generally less windy than of late.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Very windy weather with bursts of heavy rain will spread from the west across all parts Sunday night with a risk of severe gales in the northwest. Sunny spells and scattered showers returning for Monday then more wet and windy weather on Tuesday.
