Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain will affect southeastern England during at first, easing by mid-morning. Occasional rain will affect Scotland and Northern Ireland today but most parts become dry by the evening. Mainly dry elsewhere with bright or sunny spells. Most of the UK will be dry overnight with skies clearing in many places.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday will be mostly dry across the United Kingdom, with just the odd light shower in northeast Scotland. Rain will affect Scotland and Northern Ireland on Sunday, but dry again elsewhere with some sunny spells. Temperatures near normal, locally warm with light northwesterly winds.
