Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Southern Scotland and hillier parts of Northern Ireland and the far
north of England will be cold with sleet and snow, some heavy falls
in places with drifting especially over high ground. Northern
Scotland, mainly dry but cold and frosty. The rest of England and
Wales, mostly cloudy with spells of rain, some heavy and prolonged.
It'll become very windy in the south with gales spreading from the
west, locally severe in places with damaging gusts.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Cold with a risk of snow in the far north at first otherwise mild but
very unsettled with rain and strong winds at times.
