Headline:

Band of rain continuing eastwards, blustery showers following.

This Evening and Tonight:

Rain continuing eastward, finally clearing the east coast around midnight. Clear spells and blustery showers to follow, these heavy and prolonged in the northwest. Rather windy.

Saturday:

Dry and bright for a time in the east, but blustery showers in the west extending to all areas. Staying windy.

Outlook for Sunday:

Heavy, persistent rain spreading quickly from the southwest. Windy with gales in places.

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
