Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a frosty start, most places will become fine and dry with some sunny spells. Cloud amounts will increase across southeast England throughout the day with some snow showers developing at times. A brisk easterly wind in the south will accentuate the cold feel. A widespread frost developing once again across many parts of the UK overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Snow showers easing across the southeast of England on Thursday. Otherwise, generally dry with variable amounts of cloud. The risk of the odd light shower developing across the northeast of England and into eastern Scotland. Feeling cold, especially in the brisk northeasterly wind.
