Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A mostly cloudy and dry start with a few patches of fog and frost. Outbreaks of rain over Northern Ireland in the morning moving east through the day, but the southeast should remain dry with bright spells. The rain may be locally heavy with sleet or snow possible for a time over northern hills. Becoming milder in the west.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A mostly cloudy and misty day on Thursday with showery rain in places. Friday should see strengthening winds and further outbreaks of rain, locally heavy, spreading from the west. Becoming milder everywhere but with strong or gale force southerly winds developing.
