Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
An cold start, with many parts subject to frost and icy stretches. Sleet and snow will affect northern and western areas at times, turning to rain later. The southeast will remain largely dry though with some sunshine. Winds backing to the southwest and increasing.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy rain is expected in many northern areas on Sunday, spreading from the west to remaining parts by evening. Brighter weather with scattered showers at times on Monday, becoming increasingly wintry in the northwest. Further heavy rain and strong winds spreading east from Monday night, becoming showery later Tuesday.
