Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Many places will have a grey start with misty and drizzle in places,
and across northern and western Scotland, some heavier rain. However,
many central and eastern areas will become bright with some hazy
sunny spells and become very mild, although rather windy. Later, rain
will spread southeastwards across much of Scotland, Northern Ireland
and northern England with winds here becoming strong to gale force
later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will become much colder as northerly winds bring a mixture of
sunshine and showers, most of the sunshine in the west, most of the
showers in the east. Night frost will become more widespread as winds
slowly ease.
