Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cloud and outbreaks of showery rain over central and eastern England will gradually ease away eastwards during Monday, whilst elsewhere will be mostly dry with plenty of bright or sunny spells developing. Chilly north or northwesterly winds will ease through the day, and it will turn frosty in the evening.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be dry and sunny for most after a frosty start although cloud and patchy rain will arrive in the far northwest later. This cloud will spread slowly east on Wednesday though central and eastern parts will stay dry.
