Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of England and Wales will be fine, sunny, very warm and humid today, some showers breaking out in the south later though. A band of rain will be affecting the west and this will push east overnight with some locally heavy downpours, especially in the north. Some thundery showers likely in the south-east.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be unsettled across much of the country, with a mix of sunshine and scattered heavy showers. The showers perhaps prolonged and thundery across central and southeastern England. Unsettled on Thursday still with sunny spells and showers, these possibly heavy in the west. Turning cooler.
