Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Mostly rather cloudy with a little drizzle at times, this increasingly turning to light sleet or snow over central and eastern areas, perhaps bringing slight accumulations to a few places, mainly hills. Mainly dry in sheltered western areas with some bright or sunny spells. Temperatures mostly rather cold, locally cold in the east, but nearer average across northwest Scotland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Many central and eastern areas cloudy with light sleet or snow flurries, though drizzle more likely near eastern coasts. Some bright or sunny spells in sheltered western parts. Rather cold or cold for most and feeling raw in the southeasterly breeze.
