Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Eastern areas of Scotland and England mostly cloudy with rain at times, some sleet or snow at first over eastern England. Western areas brighter with sunny intervals but also showers especially in the northwest. It'll be windy over both eastern and western counties. Cold in the east at first otherwise temperatures mostly near normal with snow in the north thawing slowly.
There'll be further rain at times in the east tonight but western areas will become mostly dry.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mostly dry and cold Friday with overnight frosts. Further cloud and rain will spread to northern and western areas on Saturday.
