

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 13 Jun 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A mixture of sunny spells and scattered, locally heavy, showers is expected generally, after a chilly start. However, northern Scotland will be more cloudy with rain. Overnight that cloud and showery outbreaks of rain will move south across Scotland, N.Ireland and northern England. Elsewhere should be dry with clear spells once any daytime showers die away.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Sunny spells and scattered showers generally over the weekend, with some locally heavy outbreaks. Northern and eastern Scotland and northeast England may see more cloud and some rain on Saturday though. Temperatures around or just below normal by day with some rather chilly nights.
