

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 24 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A murky start with fog patches, and outbreaks of rain in the north and east.  
This will clear through the morning, then a mostly dry and fine day, although a  
few sharp showers are likely in places. Mist, fog and low cloud then spreading  
in from the east overnight, with outbreaks of rain returning to eastern parts  
later.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cloudy in eastern areas on Friday with outbreaks of rain. It will be drier  
further west with some sunny spells, and just isolated showers. Turning  
unsettled for Saturday for many with rain or showers but also some drier,  
brighter interludes.
