Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
After a frosty start in many areas, cloud and rain in the southwest will spread to other western areas during the morning, and to eastern areas during the afternoon. Some of the rain will be heavy, and will fall as snow over hills in Scotland. Although rather cold in some northern areas, it will slowly become milder from the southwest.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will clear the southeast on Saturday, all areas becoming sunnier with scattered showers. Showers will become frequent, falling as snow in northwest Scotland, some extending to other northwestern and eastern coasts on Sunday. Becoming rather cold or cold everywhere.
