Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in the north of Scotland will ease though the day. Elsewhere, rather cloudy at times but some sunshine is expected, particularly in the west. Showers are also likely though, heaviest in the south. Showers in the southeast will slowly ease tonight then most places will be dry with clear spells. Quite a chilly night for August.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Western parts of the UK will see the best of the bright weather on Wednesday whereas central and eastern parts will be generally cloudier, but still bright at times, with a few light showers. Most places should be dry and bright on Thursday.
