

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Sunday 17 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain over central and western parts at first should gradually die out through the morning. A few bright or sunny spells are likely in the north but central and southern parts staying mostly cloudy and fog patches in eastern areas may be slow to clear. Temperatures generally near or rather below the December average.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It should be mostly dry throughout but probably largely cloudy. Any lengthy cloud breaks at night leading to the formation of frost and patchy fog, which may linger through the day in places. Temperatures generally near or below average but cold where fog lingers.
