




Yellow warning Rain

Between
04:00 Thu 20 Sep 2018 and
22:00 Thu 20 Sep 2018



An area of persistent and heavy rain is expected to develop across Wales and northwest England.

What to expect

- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Some interruption to power supplies and other services likely
- Flooding of a few homes and business is likely

Further details

An area of rain is expected to move northeast across many parts of the UK on Thursday. Rain is likely to be most persistent and heaviest across parts of Wales and northwest England. 40-60 mm of rain is likely widely across the warning area, whilst some of the higher ground of north Wales and perhaps Cumbria could see 80-100 mm. In addition to the rain, strong winds and coastal gales can be expected across southern parts of the warning area.
