Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of heavy rain will move across the northern half of the UK today, with sunny spells and locally heavy showers in the south. Showers and rain will continue in the north and west overnight, with some rain also affecting southeast England. It will be windy throughout, especially on western coasts where gales are expected today.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

There will be showers in the north and west on Thursday and Friday, though with some brighter spells in-between. The southeast will also see rain at times. Otherwise, there will be a good deal of dry weather, with only a few, isolated showers.
