Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy and damp at first across England and Wales. A band of heavy rain will move southeastwards during the day, Sunshine and showers, already over Scotland and Northern Ireland, will follow to most parts later. Clear and cold tonight, but rain lingering over southeast England. Showers in the north and west.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

The rain in the southeast will edge northwestwards during Friday and Saturday, perhaps with some sleet or wet snow on the leading edge. Some sunshine at times to the west and north, but with scattered wintry showers too. It will turn colder everywhere.
