Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A band of rain, with some sleet and hill snow across southern England and Wales will clear away to the south in the morning. There will be brighter skies to the north, but it will be cold with a risk of icy stretches. Showers of sleet or snow will continue to affect northern and eastern coasts through the day, .

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain and hill snow will spread to all areas on Thursday, with strong westerly winds. This should clear away to the east on Friday, leaving a bright but cold day with wintry showers. Brisk winds should ease through the day.
