Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
A dry day for much of England, Wales and Northern Ireland with bright or sunny spells, despite a fair amount of cloud. A few showers may occur, mainly near to eastern coasts, but these will be light. Across Scotland, rain will reach northern areas during the morning, arriving over central parts by midday and spreading to many southern areas during the afternoon. Temperatures near normal, and feeling pleasant enough in the sunshine.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Rain soon clearing southern parts on Thursday to give a dry, bright day for most. Rain moving south on Friday with colder conditions following from the north.
