Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most areas will be dry with mist lifting to leave plenty of sunshine. However, cloud will affect northern and eastern Scotland and eastern England, along with Northern Ireland and westernmost parts of Britain, giving isolated showers. Overnight, Northern Ireland, eastern parts of England and Scotland will be cloudy with a few showers. It will be clearer elsewhere with fog patches.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday will be generally dry and settled with sunny spells and a light southeasterly wind, although the north and east of Britain will be cloudier at times. It will remain fine on Wednesday with some warm sunshine developing at times.
