

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Snow will clear northeastward from Scotland and northern England this morning. Elsewhere will be mostly cloudy and dull. It will gradually turn less cold from the south, but a band of rain, preceded by sleet and snow over Northern Ireland and upland Scotland will push in from the west, across most parts by evening.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Milder and often breezy across the whole of the UK but still the risk of snow at times over the Scottish mountains. Generally unsettled with bands of rain or showers at times, but also some brighter intervals particularly on Sunday.
