

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Wet and windy weather spreading northeastwards through the day. Outbreaks of rain turning heavy and persistent in places, leading to a risk of localised flooding, mainly in areas recently affected. Windy across most areas, with gales in exposure. Overnight clear spells and scattered, heavy and blustery, showers, which may merge into longer spells of heavy rain in places.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Bright and breezy on Thursday, with a scattering of showers, especially across western areas. Best of the drier and brighter weather in the east. A spell of more persistent rain and very strong winds overnight, clearing to sunshine and blustery showers Friday.
