Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of heavy rain across southeastern England should gradually clear away, clearing Kent by mid afternoon. Otherwise, sunshine and showers, with some of the showers becoming heavy with a risk of hail and thunder. It will be become increasingly windy in the south and southwest with strong winds at times.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Sunshine and showers for Wednesday with some of the showers becoming heavy, prolonged and blustery with a risk of thunder. Windy too, especially in the south and southwest. Thursday will be the best day of the week for many areas with fewer showers and more sunshine.
