Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mostly dry with variable cloud and the best of the sunshine in the south. Some patchy light rain in the north, slowly edging southwards, also some isolated snow flurries in the south at first. Cold, especially in the bitter breeze in the south. Frosty overnight, particularly in the south.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Cloudy and less cold conditions edge southwards Saturday with some patchy light rain at times. Brighter conditions with some sunny spells following. Winds easing in south, but increasing in the northeast. Mainly dry but rather cloudy Sunday, with some sunny spells and becoming less cold. Patchy overnight frost in clear spells.
