Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern Scotland mostly dry throughout. Elsewhere rain, locally heavy, and strong winds will continue to extend northwards today, becoming slow moving overnight across Northern Ireland, northern England and much of Scotland. Broken cloud with thundery showers will follow across England and Wales.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday will be generally cloudy and cool with showers or longer spells of rain, although the far north of Scotland will remain dry. Windy and feeling cool across Northern Ireland, Scotland, southeastern and northern England. Sunday showers or longer spells of rain across eastern parts, gradually being replaced by drier and brighter weather from the west.
