Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 29 June to 1200 UTC Tuesday 30 June 2015

General Situation

An area of high pressure, centred near northwestern France, will move over low countries tonight, before then drifting towards Denmark on Tuesday. An area of low pressure will remain centred over the east Atlantic. The resulting southerly flow will draw increasingly hot and humid air northwards through next 48 hours.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in the Moray Firth.

Showers at first, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later, becoming variable 3 or less for a time at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Moray Firth.

Thundery showers developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in north.

Rain for a time later.

Good, occasionally poor for a time later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers for a time later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain for a time later.

Good, occasionally poor for a time later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Fair.
Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southerly, becoming southeasterly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, backing easterly or northeasterly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing east later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East, backing southeast later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

South backing southeast, 3 or 4, then backing east 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in lyme bay.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast becoming cyclonic, 5 or 6, then becoming southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Fog patches, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less at first in Bristol Channel, otherwise south 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, then becoming west or southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Mainly fair, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, backing southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly, becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in northwest.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later near Mull of Galloway.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in north.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Mainly fair, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South backing east, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, backing southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 until later in North Channel.

Slight or moderate.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, backing southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 until later in North Channel.

Slight or moderate.

Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, backing southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time.

Moderate.

Showers then rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time in south.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at first, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 29 Jun 2015 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 30 Jun 2015 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak occlusion soon clears to the north as a weak ridge builds over Shetland.

A further occlusion moves over the area from the southwest on Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

South or southwest 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 30 Jun until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 30 Jun:
South 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair then rain, fog patches later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming east to northeast later this afternoon and increasing 3 to 4 in the evening, veering east to southeast 2 to 4 around dawn.
Smooth or slight.
Mist or fog patches slowly clearing during the afternoon.
Good, occasionally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to southeast 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 early evening, perhaps 6 in the north, veering south to southwest by midday Wednesday and decreasing 3 to 4.
Slight to moderate with an increasing swell.
Fair or fine, becoming rather cloudy on Wednesday with isolated thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate to poor in showers.

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
