Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
In southeast England and East Anglia, outbreaks of rain or sleet are expected with snow on higher ground, perhaps reaching lower levels early and late in the day. For the rest of England and Wales, rain, sleet or snow may give early snowfall on low ground as well over hills before brighter skies with wintry showers follows from the north.

Over Scotland and Northern Ireland, some sunshine is likely with wintry showers mostly confined to northern and eastern Scotland. Everywhere will be cold with some frost morning and evening.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Rather unsettled, although with snow becoming confined to northern hills.
