Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Most places cloudy and mild, with rain becoming persistent over Scotland and Northern Ireland. There will be patchy rain or drizzle, mist and hill fog elsewhere in the west, whereas it should become brighter in the east. Overnight, cloud will clear much of England and Wales, but rain will become showery over Scotland and Northern Ireland. Winds strengthening.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Tuesday, patchy rain giving way to showers, particularly in the east. The west will be sunny. Strong to gale winds and becoming colder. Wednesday, overnight frost inland in west, then dry and sunny. Showers and strong winds in east easing.
