

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 06 Oct 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of rain initially lying across the far north of Scotland will spread southeastwards during Saturday, weakening to leave some patchy drizzle over the central lowlands overnight into Sunday morning. Remaining parts of Britain dry, rather cloudy over central and eastern England. Sunny spells developing once fog patches clear. Rather warm in the sunny spells with light winds.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Light rain or drizzle will lie across southern Scotland and the far north of England during Sunday and into Monday. Remaining areas mainly dry with variable cloud, rain reaching western parts later on Monday. Overnight fog patches clearing then sunny spells.
