Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Most places cloudy today, with some intermittent, mainly light rain, this most frequent in southwest England, Wales and Northern Ireland. Northwest Scotland and perhaps southern England may see some brighter spells at times. Overnight, still cloudy and misty, with the outbreaks of rain becoming more frequent and widespread but still mainly light.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Continuing predominantly cloudy and dull, with rain or drizzle for most areas at times. Hill fog will become fairly widespread, with southern Britain also seeing extensive coastal fog. Northern Scotland will often be quite windy, and temperatures are expected to be generally around normal for early March.
