

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting cold and crisp for many with sunny periods. However, in southern England it will be dull and mild with cloudy skies and outbreaks of rain, locally heavy along southern coasts. This spreads north later, with some heavier more persistent rain across Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight. Cloudy for many with some mist and fog patches.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Rather cloudy with mist, and some drizzle, but brighter warmer spells too Thursday. The rain, will become heavy across Scotland and Northern Ireland later where it turns breezy. Cloudy in the north with freshening winds Friday, but becoming bright and warm across the southeast.
