Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain will spread across the northern half of the country, giving some temporary snow on its leading edge. Otherwise most of the UK will be dry with cloud increasing from the west. Winds will also be much lighter than they were on Thursday. Temperatures will generally be near normal, however it will be much colder in the northeast.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

This weekend will become increasingly mild from the south and west, as much more settled but also cloudy conditions prevail for much of the country. However, across the north outbreaks of rain and some stronger winds are likely at times.
