REMARKS.

Monday.

This morning a diminution in barometrical pressure is shown since yesterday, although readings in the N. are still higher than those reported on Saturday. The change in pressure during the last 12 hours has been generally slight, and on the W. Coast of France no difference is observed since last evening. The greatest pressures are on the E. coast of England.

The temperature has remained nearly steady during the last 48 hours.

Winds have been light and variable, and continue so.

Weather is generally dry and fine on the N & E. coasts: on other coasts the sky is generally overcast.

2 Pm: Pressure has diminished slightly except in the SW— at Penzance and Valencia an increase has taken place since the morning.

Considerable differences exist in temperature: it is generally lower than it was yesterday.

Winds continue moderate, and are chiefly from NW to SW.

Some rain has fallen on our western coasts. Fog and mist are reported from the S.W. The sky is generally cloudy.

REMARKS.

Wednesday, 14 June 1868.

Wednesday. Since yesterday the change in barometrical pressure has been small, and readings are slightly higher this morning at all stations, except in the SW of Ireland:— At Valencia the decrease has been since 6 P.M. one tenth of an inch. The pressures at southern stations are very uniform, and exceed those in the North of Scotland by nearly 3 tenths.

Temperature is a little lower at eastern stations.

Winds continue light to moderate, and are generally westerly at all stations, except Corunna, where a ^{NE wind is felt} strong breeze. Rain has fallen in the S of Ireland and on our E. coast. In the North the weather is fine, but on other coasts it is cloudy.

2 P.M.:

On the western coast pressure has considerably decreased since the morning, and the southerly wind at Valencia has become stronger.

Considerable differences exist this morning in the barometrical pressures over our islands, and readings in the N. of Scotland are about 4 tenths of an inch lower than yesterday; but the change in the W. of Ireland is small, as pressure has again recovered itself during the night. The least reading reported is at Nairn, and is 7 tenths of an inch below that at Biarritz.

Temperature has changed very little. Strong winds from the southwards sprang up on the W. coast of Ireland and in the Irish Channel during yesterday: moderate westerly winds prevail generally this morning in England-northwesterly in Scotland and Ireland.

Rain has fallen in the SW, where much mist has prevailed. The sky is generally cloudy or overcast.

2 Pm:

At southern stations pressure has been stationary since the morning, but on other coasts it has increased - at Nairn very rapidly. Winds continue westerly.

Friday.

The increase in barometrical pressure, occurring in the N. yesterday afternoon, has amounted to half an inch during the last 24 hours. This increase has been general on our other coasts, but of less extent; whilst at southern continental stations the pressure has been nearly steady: it is now high at all stations.

Temperature is somewhat less in the S. of England.

The winds yesterday were chiefly from the westward and moderate, and are now light and variable.

Some rain is reported from the S. coast of England, where the weather is cloudy. In Ireland it is misty, but on the north and east coasts the sky is clear.

2 P.M.: In the N. of Scotland a slight decrease in pressure has taken place since the morning, but on other coasts readings are a little greater.

The weather on the S. coast of England and on the continent is fine: it is generally overcast in our other districts. Thunder is reported from Valencia. A little rain has fallen in the NW.

2 P.M. - Pressure has increased slightly in the N, but at other Stations a small decrease is shown. A thunderstorm is reported from Toulon.

The weather is generally dry, and the sky overcast; but at GreenCastle a little rain is reported. Fog, with mist, has prevailed in the W.

On the N and E. coasts pressure has diminished considerably at Vain. In Ireland, where the wind has freshened from the westward, an increase has occurred since the morning.

REMARKS.

Wednesday. During yesterday a general diminution in atmospheric pressure took place at all stations: the change exceeded 3 tenths of an inch in the N. but was slight elsewhere. The difference of readings between Vain and Plymouth is 4 tenths of an inch.

Temperature has risen in the N. it continues generally high at other stations.

At stations in the east and south there was a diminution yesterday, but this has been succeeded by an increase to-day on our coasts. In the south of France readings have decreased steadily, and that at Toulon is ~~more than~~ 0.6 in. below that at Valencia.

Temperature after increasing in the south yesterday has again diminished.

The most prevalent winds during yesterday were from the northward; but this morning they have drawn more easterly on our eastern and Channel coasts. Their force is moderate.

Fine, but somewhat cloudy weather has been and is still prevalent.

2 P.M. Pressure has decreased very slightly in the north and east.
