Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Much of Scotland and Northern Ireland will have bright spells,
although thicker cloud and patchy rain may affect the far north.
Clouds will also increase across central and eastern Scotland later.
Over England and Wales, starting cloudy and mainly dry, just some
patchy rain across parts of Wales and central England at first. Most
areas then seeing warm sunshine develop, but remaining cloudy in the
west and southwest. Patchy rain may spread to Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
England and Wales will be mostly dry with some sunshine at times,
becoming very warm, whilst cloud and rain affects northwestern areas
at times.
