Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mostly cloudy, though some brighter spells at times. Patchy rain and drizzle will spread from the west, affecting all parts by dawn tomorrow, perhaps turning to sleet for a time over high ground in the northeast. Cold in the east with milder air edging eastwards across the country by tomorrow.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Fairly cloudy again on Tuesday. A band of rain will spread to northwest Scotland through the morning, then Northern Ireland, northern England, Wales and southern Scotland during the afternoon. The rain will sweep southeastwards across the rest of the UK on Wednesday, followed by sunny spells and isolated showers.
